Arts In The Park

Arts In The Park, "Art In The Heart of Hamblen County," is a one-day celebration of visual and performing arts—two-dimensional fine art, artistic photography, and sculpture, theatre, music, and dance. Arts In the Park is an event for Morristown Art Association Member artists, as well as other local visual artists, to showcase, display, sell, and demonstrate two-dimensional fine art, artistic photography, and sculpture. Local music and theatre groups perform on two stages and throughout the park. Fine art, exciting live performances, fine food and refreshments, demonstrations, an art walk, and children's activities will add to the festival's appeal. Admission is FREE. This 12th Annual Arts In The Park event will draw visitors and patrons from throughout east Tennessee and the surrounding areas. Arts In The Park is an event of the Morristown Art Association, Morristown Parks and Recreation, and Rose Center Council for the Arts.

SELECTION

This is a juried event. Every applying artist is juried. Work should exhibit excellence in technique and concept and show imagination and the mark of individuality. All work must be original to and created by the exhibitor. Work other than that of the applying artist is not acceptable. The Arts In The Park jury committee reserves the right to eliminate any item or booth that does not meet these criteria.

WHAT TO SUBMIT

Three high-quality color photos of your work. Write your name and address on each photo. Number the photos 1 thru 3 and submit a brief description of each photo. Include the price of each item and list the price range of your work. Photos must include examples of ALL art media intended for sale. *Only submit photos representing what you will be selling.* Photos will not be returned. To aid in the jurying process, please submit, along with your application, a two-paragraph biography explaining your artwork and experience. Application is included on back of brochure.

Each application must be accompanied by a \$5 non-refundable application fee, along with the \$25 booth fee, for a total payment of \$30. Morristown Art Association Members with a paid membership are refunded the \$25 booth fee at the end of the day.

BOOTH FEE

The booth fee is \$25 and must be submitted with the application. Electricity, tents, tables, and booth props are NOT provided for this outdoor event. Exhibitor must provide all booth setup equipment. The event will be held rain or shine.

BOOTH SIZE & DISPLAY

Should your booth size exceed 10 x 20 feet, this information needs to be provided on the application, for allocation of space. All booths will be judged for presentation of work displayed, creativity used in display, and neatness in setup and design. A ribbon will be given for Best Display.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Booth cancellation on or before August 15, 100 percent of the \$25 booth fee will be refunded. **NO** refunds for cancellation after August 15. Detailed event information will be mailed upon acceptance.

WHO MAY NOT PARTICIPATE

No crafters, commercial agents, dealers, or manufacturers may enter. Arts In The Park Committee reserves the right to remove any work that differs markedly in nature or intent from that originally submitted for jurying.
